



## **Diotrol Golden Oil Preparator**

Description	The multi-purpose Diotrol Golden Oil Preparator is an environmentally friendly, biological solvent without any petrochemical ingredients.
	It's been produced by using only regenerating resources. The included lactic acid ester is created by natural fermentation of sugar and corn glucose. The preparator is biodegradable, contains 0% VOC and no harmful substances.
	Diotrol Golden Oil Preparator supports the application of solvent-free oils on wide areas. It can be used to dilute Diotrol Golden Oil Onecoat or Alba White or as a cleaner and passivator (support of absorbents) for preparation of raw woodwork.
	Due to the osmotic pressure (molecular leveling penetration) the following oil will penetrate through the wood cell of coniferous wood, thus the complete saturation of the sur-face will be achieved. In case of deciduous wood, the pores will be cleaned and opened, so the oil can penetrate by capillarity.
Application area	<b>As a cleaner and passivator</b> for floors, wall and ceiling paneling or interior furniture, which will be treated with <i>Diotrol Golden Oil Onecoat</i> .
	<b>To dilute</b> Diotrol Golden Oil Onecoat or Alba White.
Appearance	Clear liquid
Smell	Bloomy
Flashpoint	>120°C
Spec. Gravity	1.005 kg/l
Packaging	50ml, 250ml, 1L, 5L
Storage	12 months in appropriate, cool place in closed original packaging. Store in a cool and dry place.
Procedure	<ul> <li>Precondition</li> <li>Substrate must be free from dust.</li> <li>Substrate may not have any loose particles or rest of old paint-coating.</li> </ul>





## Procedure

- 1. Apply Diotrol Golden Oil Preparator with a soft rag or pad and spread it evenly by wiping motion. Thereby dust and pollution will be eliminated.
- 2. The cleaned area can be oiled even if it is still damp (consult the technical data sheet Diotrol Golden Oil Onecoat).

The wood surface will not dry off. The preparator and oil will dry homogeneous.

	In case of a spray application, we recommend to levell / smooth the surface with a brush.
	Do not apply at outside temperatures below 10°C or above 30°C or at extreme humidity of mor than 70%. Avoid direct sunlight.
	When applying indoors, ensure good ventilation.
Consumption	With 1L you can prepare approx. 50 - 100m <sup>2</sup>
	May depend on the nature and absorbency of the substrate.
Dilution	Ready for use.
Cleaning of tools	Immediately after use with turpentine substitute or universal thinner.
	Dissolve dry paint residues with nitro thinner or brush cleaner.





	Wash brush in lye to keep the bristles supple.
Important remarks	<ul> <li>Saturated rags can ignite by themselves. Spread and let them dry in the open air, or store them in an airtight metal can.</li> </ul>
	Keep away from sources of ignition. Avoid sources of fire during work.
